### **CAMEO Hazardous Materials Software Training**

The CAMEO (Computer Aided Management of Emergency Operations) Suite is one of the finest overall tools for hazardous materials emergency planning and response. It is a set of three computer programs that includes the CAMEO database (with information on more than 6,000 chemicals), the ALOHA air plume modeling program, and the MARPLOT mapping program. This course will teach you how to use these programs together to assist in hazardous materials emergency response and emergency planning. By the end of this course, you will be able to find information on a chemical within seconds; plot where that chemical will travel over a map of your city; store chemical and emergency information for chemical facilities in your area; store information regarding sensitive populations; plot the locations of all these facilities; use the CAMEO Suite to enhance your emergency planning and to provide critical data in the event of a hazardous materials emergency. This is an elective course in the *Workplace Health and Safety Certificate Program*.

**Instructor:** Kevin Smith serves as deputy fire marshal, hazardous materials, for the Chino Valley Fire District in San Bernardino County. He has been involved in the management of hazardous materials emergency response and planning in the fire service since 1986. Smith has responded to hundreds of hazardous materials incidents, and is one of 37 Federally certified CAMEO Instructors in the nation.

**When:** Enroll now through November 1, 2006. You will receive your password via email within two business days of enrolling. (No passwords will be given prior to September 18.) All coursework must be completed by December 15th, 2006.

**Format:** You must begin and end the course on the dates noted above. You may work at your own pace during this time frame. You must provide your email address when enrolling to receive your password. Please set up your email account to receive email from "extensiondlc.net" otherwise the email containing your password may not reach your inbox. You will receive your password via email on the start date, or within two business days of enrolling if you enroll after the start date. From the day you receive your password you will have until the completion date noted above to complete the course. **Technical requirements:** A multimedia capable computer, a current email account and access to the Web using an Internet browser.

**Fee:** \$350 Includes course materials and instructional support.

**Special Discount fee:** \$315.00 for organizations enrolling three or more people at the same time in the same course. All registrations must be submitted at the same time and fees paid with one check, credit card or purchase order.

**Credit:** 4 quarter units academic credit, X431.40, 4 CEUs, 40 Hours, 5 ABIH CEUs

**Withdrawals:** Requests to withdraw from a course must be received in writing via email before your login expires. Send an email to [registration@unexdlc.ucdavis.edu](mailto:registration@unexdlc.ucdavis.edu) requesting a withdrawal. You will need to include your name, the course title and the course section number. Following the proper withdrawal procedure will ensure an appropriate grade assignment.

**Refunds/transfers:** Refund or transfer requests will be approved, less a \$60 processing fee, if a written email request, sent to [registration@unexdlc.ucdavis.edu](mailto:registration@unexdlc.ucdavis.edu) is received within two weeks of your start date and if you have not gone beyond Lesson 1 of the course. You will need to include your name, the course title and the course section number.

**Extensions:** Extension requests will be granted for one (1) eight-week period for a \$60 processing fee. Send an email to [registration@unexdlc.ucdavis.edu](mailto:registration@unexdlc.ucdavis.edu) requesting an extension. Your request must be received prior to your log-in expiration date. If you allow your enrollment to expire or if you do not complete your course by the end date of your extension, you must pay the full course fee to re-enroll.
